Create With Claudia Mystery Quilt Along 2020


December

We've made 33 blocks and we are finally ready to assemble the top. The quilt top is laid out with six blocks across and six blocks down. We will begin by sewing the individual blocks to form rows.

Row 1:

Form row in the following order, beginning on the left:

- Block 1: Half Square Triangle from February
- Block 2: Friendship Star from March
- Block 3: Churn Dash from September
- Block 4: Contrary Wife from October
- Block 5: Pinwheel from August
- Block 6: Half Square Triangle from February




Block 1	Block 2	Block 3	Block 4	Block 5	Block 6
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Row 2:

Form row in the following order, beginning on the left:

- Block 1: Bear's Paw from May
- Block 2: Half Square Triangle from February
- Block 3: Nine Patch from January
- Block 4: Nine Patch from January
- Block 5: Half Square Triangle from February
- Block 6: Shoofly from July



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Rows 3 & 4:

Because of the larger block in the center, these need to be sewn a bit differently.

First, sew the following blocks together to form the left side of the rows 3 & 4.

Sew together (from left to right)

Row 3:


Block 1:	Sawtooth Star from April

Block 2: Nine Patch from January

Row 4:

Block 1:	Old Maid's Puzzle from June
Block 2:	Nine Patch from January

Then sew the units together as shown below.



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
Then sew the following blocks together to form the latter section of these rows.

Row 3:

- Block 1: Nine Patch from January
- Block 2: Old Maid's Puzzle from June


Row 4:

Block 1:	Nine Patch from January
Block 2:	Sawtooth Star from April



Then assemble rows 3 & 4 as shown:

The center block is the one we made in December.



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
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Row 5:

Form row in the following order, beginning on the left:


- Block 1: Shoofly from July
- Block 2: Half Square Triangle from February
- Block 3: Nine Patch from January
- Block 4: Nine Patch from January
- Block 5: Half Square Triangle from February
- Block 6: Shoofly from July Bear's Paw from May



Row 6:

Form row in the following order, beginning on the left:

- Block 1: Half Square Triangle from February
- Block 2: Pinwheel from August
- Block 3: Contrary Wife from October
- Block 4: Churn Dash from September
- Block 5: Friendship Star from March
- Block 6: Half Square Triangle from February



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
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Create With Claudia Mystery Quilt Along 2020 Use a scant ¹/₄ inch seam allowance

Use a scant ¼ inch seam allowance Fabric requirements listed are generous • Arrows indicate pressing direction

Sew the rows together to form the quilt top.

Once finished with the top, you can back, quilt and bind as desired.
