Notes Before You Begin

- Please read through all instructions carefully before beginning
- 1/4 inch seam allowance is used throughout

Fabric Needed

Pieces of scrap fabric as follows:

- Pink 1 piece
- Purple 5 pieces
- Blue 9 pieces
- Turquoise 13 pieces
- Green 17 pieces
- Yellow 21 pieces
- Orange 25 pieces
- Red 29 pieces

Cutting Instructions

Cut all scraps into 2" squares.

Assembly

Lay out the squares as shown. Then sew the individual squares together.

Tip: Sew together the shorter columns first, then piece all of the columns together. There are not as many pieces to get confused when you start with the shorter ones.

Mini Quilt Assembly

- 1. Lay your backing fabric on a long surface, with wrong side facing up.
- 2. Next, lay your batting on top of the backing.
- 3. Lastly, lay the mini quilt on top with the right side facing up.
- 4. Baste the layers together using your preferred method.
- 5. Quilt as desired.
- 6. Bind using your preferred method.
