


Easy Precut Quilt #3



Pattern Information – Read all instructions carefully before beginning

- Finished size is approximately 66" x 89"
- ¼ inch seam allowance used
- Width of fabric is assumed to be 41"
- Diagrams are not to scale

Fabric Needed

- Focal Fabric - One pack of 10" precuts (with at least 40 in it)
- Background Fabric – 4 1/8 yards
- Backing – 5 1/2 yards (or more depending on your method of quilting)
- Binding – If you use 2 ½" wide strips to bind then you will need 5/8 yard plus one more strip that is 2 ½" by width of fabric. You may need more or less depending on your method of binding.

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
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This quilt is made up of 3 different blocks using 10" precuts and background fabric.

Making the Blocks

Block 1

This is the easiest block of all. Pick out 13 – 10" squares from the precut pack and set aside. (fig. 1)



Block 2

Cutting for Block 2:

From the background fabric:

- Piece A – 3 1/2" x 4 1/4" – 28 pieces
- Piece B – 2 1/2" x 4 1/4" – 28 pieces
- Piece C – 1 3/4" x 4 1/4" – 56 pieces
- Piece D – 1 3/4" x 2 1/2" – 56 pieces
- Piece E – 1" x 2 1/2" – 56 pieces

From the precut pack:

- Piece F – 2 1/2" square – 70 pieces *Note: 5 of these are used for each Block 2. I like to use 4 of the same fabric for the outside and a different one for the center.

Sew a piece D to the top of a piece F. Then sew a piece E to the bottom. Repeat until you have four of these units. (fig. 2) Sew a piece C to the left side of 1 of the units. Sew a piece C to the right side of another unit. (fig. 3) Join these two sections together with a piece A. (fig. 4) Repeat so there are two sections like fig. 4. Set aside.








Sew a piece B to the left and right a piece F. (fig. 5)



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Add one of the sections made in fig. 4 to the top of the section made in fig. 5. Add another to the bottom. (fig. 6) The block should measure 10". Make 14 of Block 2.



Block 3

Cutting for Block 3:

From the precut pack:

- Piece G – 5" square – 36 pieces

From the background fabric:

- Piece H – 3" x 5" – 72 pieces
- Piece I – 3" x 10" – 72 pieces

Sew a piece H to the top and the bottom of a piece G. (fig. 7) Then sew a piece I to the left and right of the section just made. (fig. 8) Block should measure 10". Make 36 of Block 3.





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
Quilt Top Assembly

The quilt is made up of two different row layouts and a total of 9 rows.


Rows 1, 3, 5, 7 and 9 are laid out as shown in fig. 9. From left to right the order is Block 3, Block 2, Block 3, Block 1, Block 3, Block 2, Block 3.



Rows 2, 4, 6 and 8 are laid out as shown in fig. 10. From left to right the order is Block 3, Block 1, Block 3, Block 2, Block 3, Block 1, Block 3.



Sew the individual rows together first. Then sew the completed rows together.



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
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Adding the Border

Cut 4 strips 2 1/2" x 33 1/2". On the short end sew together two of the strips. Repeat with the remaining strips. (fig. 9)



Add one strip to the top and one to the bottom.



Finishing the Quilt

1. Lay your backing fabric on a long surface, with wrong side facing up.
2. Next, lay your batting on top of the backing.
3. Lastly, lay your quilt top on top with the right side facing up.
4. Baste the layers together using your preferred basting method.
5. Quilt as desired.
6. Bind using your preferred method. I use 2.5" strips when I bind.


